Make sure your camper comes prepared to enjoy the camp store. Snacks (\$1-\$2), drinks (\$2-\$4), t-shirts (\$20-\$25), and more will all be available at Bucks!

FORMS & ALLERGIES

Before arriving at camp, please speak to your group leader for information on forms. This online registration must be completed for your camper to attend.

Each parent has the option to sign up for a gluten free meal plan for your camper for a small additional charge (\$15 for the entire camp week, used for additional food purchases and preparation). Our kitchen is a peanut, tree-nut, and shell fish free facility. Any additional food allergies must be accommodated by each parent. We have a fridge and freezer available to store supplemental food.

MEDICATION

All medication must be self-administered by the camper, with assistance from their group leader or another designated adult. Any medication should be communicated to the group leader and managed directly by them. Crowders Camps does not maintain a dispensary and is not able to administer medication.

ENVIRONMENTAL (BEESTINGS, DUST, POLLEN, ETC) ALLERGIES Allergies should be communicated to the group leader.

MEDICAL POLICIES

Crowders Camps does not provide on-site medical care. Our staff are trained in CPR and basic first aid. We do have AED's on site. By signing this form, parents understand that medical care should first be administered by the group leader in charge of the camper.

CAMP RULES

Camp is about Jesus.

The rules we set in place aren't to be legalistic or stifle anyone's freedom, but rather to take away distractions and disagreements, and help campers see Jesus in every part of their week. For this reason, we have the following policies in place:

CELL PHONES

Cell phone use is at the discretion of your church group, however, Crowders highly recommends unplugging for the week! Crowders Camps will not be held liable for any lost or stolen cell phones.

GENERAL BULES

- No alcohol, tobacco, vaping, or drugs of any kind permitted anywhere on campus.
- Nothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco, vaping, or drugs of any kind, sexual content, racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
- No weapons, fireworks, or any type of incendiary
- No males in females' cabins or dorms and vice versa, at any time. No exceptions.
- No pranks or any act of vandalism.
- No profanity.

Each bag contains the basics of toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, crackers, tissue, bandaids as well as the gospel presentation. Campers will bring these items to camp, pack the bags and then churches are encouraged to contact the camp on how they can get these bags and distribute them throughout their community. It is a great first step to meeting people where they are and introducing them to the life changing love of Christ.
